In 2019 PPA, with BEN and Qhubeka won a tender from the Western Cape Government Department of Transport and Public Works for a period of three years, where 400 bicycles per year would be distributed.

The Provincial Sustainable Transport Programme Bicycle Distribution Programme (PSTP) aims to develop sustainable transport systems through forming partnerships with key stakeholders, including local municipalities. The objective of these partnerships is to support the development of sustainable transport in the Western Cape.

The pilot bicycle distribution project investigated mobility programs for learners and adults. However, with the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, the distribution plan was reprioritised to be more responsive to the immediate needs related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

We have adjusted our safety course to comply with safety regulations by emphasising the usage of masks and observing social distancing as per government law. We produced a safety video which we distribute to all recipients as well.

Due to the prevailing COVID-19 pandemic, there has been an increase in bicycle usage. The bicycle is being used to deliver food to the sick and aged which has created business opportunities within townships and for community safety programmes.

We will remain committed to enabling strong partnerships, creating access to bicycles to those who can least afford it, provide an end-to-end package for bicycle distribution and support a range of mobility projects in a collaborative approach.
