

BIKE4ALL

The Bike4All collaboration has come into its own particularly with the provincially funded PSTP Bicycle Distribution Programme. Due to challenges, Qhubeka Charity was unable to provide the bicycles for the programme and Bike4All therefore supplied the bicycles.

The COVID pandemic has forced us to rethink some of the big distributions. We focused on ensuring that our distributed bicycles have an impact in terms of COVID relief and economic recovery. This has resulted in smaller, more focused distributions.



800 bicycles have been distributed to SMME's and community safety groups all over the Western Cape. With the schools slowly normalising, we have started including scholar mobility as well.



Through our distributions we have cultivated relationships with various community focused organisations such as Khaltsha Cycles. These relationships have proven to play a role in our interactions with communities and the impact of the bicycle and strengthening the cycling communities in these difficult times.



We tightened our MOU's and impact follow up and are now in a much better position to track the sustainability and impact of our distributions. This has improved our monitoring of the ongoing condition and maintenance of the bicycles distributed.

In strengthening our partnerships and collaborations we can create more access to bicycles. The footprint will be far greater footprint working together.
